Gunnar Hall Jensen ([IMDb](#)), born in 1963, has a cand. philol. degree in media and mass communications from the University of Bergen. Over the course of his career he has made several feature documentary films, TV series and short films, in addition to commercials, music videos and commissioned films throughout his career. His debut feature documentary *Gunnar Goes Comfortable* premiered in 2003, and was selected for competition at several festivals, including IDFA, CPH:DOX and AFI Silverdocs. It was released theatrically in both Norway and Poland before being broadcast on NRK and Canal Digital. He followed up with a sequel, *Gunnar Goes God*, in 2011, which was selected for festivals like Visions De Réel, CPH:DOX, Jihlava, Doc Leipzig and many more. In 2014 he released the more experimental feature documentary *A Cup of Tea*, which again saw him nominated at CPH:DOX, DocPoint, BIFF and more. His collaboration with UpNorth Film began with the documentary *Oh, it Hertz!*, which had its world premiere at CPH:DOX 2021, and went on to win several awards. The film was later released on platforms like Prime Video and iTunes. His upcoming feature documentary produced by UpNorth Film, *Portrait of a Confused Father*, is set for release in early 2025 and is already pre-sold to BBC, NRK, DR, SVT, France TV and more. His next project will be another feature documentary with UpNorth, titled *Lights*, now in development. Gunnar currently resides in Sundsvall, Sweden, where he also produces independent documentaries through his company, Jensen Production.
